The 2007 Sacramento Cooperative Community Fund grantees are reporting back as they complete their projects. For example, Training Toward Self Reliance reports that “We used our micro-grant to grow container tomatoes on our site, and then... got a plot at the Southside Community Garden where we continued with tomatoes and more veggies... green beans, collard greens, elephant garlic and two kinds of cabbage. Our SCCF grant was the catalyst for all this, some great meals... and our continuing love affair with gardening.”

And Planned Parenthood’s Mar Monte reports that the new child care provider (supported in part by the SCCF grant) was able to streamline and standardize procedures at the Teen Success program sites and create new activity schedules for the children. The improved child care structure has resulted in more and happier children participating while their parents attend the program meetings.
